



Inter-Society Color Council Award Nomination Form and Information

The ISCC has three major awards: Godlove Award, Macbeth Award, and Nickerson Service Award. More details about the award and a list of recipients can be found on the ISCC website <http://www.iscc.org/functions/awards.php>. Nominations are accepted continuously and awarded as described in the award explanations below. This document includes the award criteria, directions for submitting a nomination, and a nomination form.

Godlove Award – awarded in odd years

The Godlove Award is the most prestigious award bestowed by the Inter-Society Color Council, and honors long term contributions in the field of color. Candidates will be judged by their contribution to any of the fields of interest related to color, whether or not it is represented by a Member-Body. A candidate's contribution is to be considered in the light of the objectives of the Council as defined in Article II of the Constitution. This contribution may be direct, it may be in the active practical stimulation of the application of color, or it may be an outstanding dissemination of knowledge of color by writing or lecturing, based upon original contributions of the nominee. The candidate need not have been active in the affairs of the Council, but they must be current or former members of the ISCC. All candidates must have had at least five years of experience in their particular field of color.

Macbeth Award – awarded in even years

The Macbeth Award is given for one or more recent outstanding contributions in the field of color. It is to be presented to a member, or former member, of the Council. The contributions shall have advanced the field of color, interpreted broadly as in the objectives of the Council as defined in Article II of the Constitution. The merit of a candidate shall be judged by his or her contributions to any of the fields of interest related to color. The contribution to color may be direct, it may be in the active practical stimulation of the application of color, or it may be an outstanding dissemination of knowledge of color by writing or lecturing. The candidates for the Macbeth Award need not have been active in the affairs of the Council.

The Nickerson Service Award – awarded as deemed appropriate

The Nickerson Service Award is presented by the Inter-Society Color Council to honor long term contributions towards the advancement of the Council and its aims and purposes. The contribution may be in the form of organizational, clerical, technical, or other services that benefit the Council and its members. The candidates must be members of the Council and must have been active in the affairs of the Council.

Submitting a nomination:

Any ISCC member may submit a nomination for any of the awards. You may use the form found in this document or create your own nomination with the appropriate information included. The nomination should be submitted to the ISCC Secretary either by email or postal mail. Then the Secretary will direct the nomination to the appropriate current award chair.

Note: Confidentiality of the nomination is of the utmost importance. The nominating individual/group must ensure that the nomination is not disclosed to the proposed nominee. If any of the above information cannot be obtained without risking disclosure, then the information should be omitted from the nominating letter.
